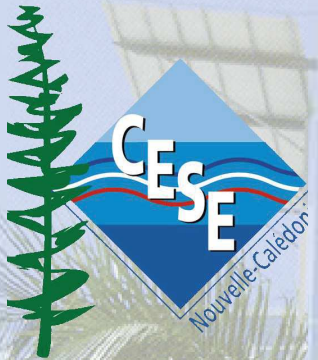

Le conseil économique, social et environnemental de Nouvelle-Calédonie

CESE-NC is a consultative organ, which has its roots in the national french CESE and its locals representation (CESER). It was instituted in it's actual form by the organic law n°99-209 of 1999.

CESE's missions?

CESE is consulted about country's projects and bills of law and congress deliberations which have economic, social and environmental characteristics. He is seized by the president of government, the president of congress for projects of bills of law.

Besides, provinces assemblies, customary senate or government can consult CESE on various subjects. The institution has a deadline of one month to give his opinion, returned to fifteen days in case of urgency.

By his own initiative, CESE can realise studies about subjects regarding New Caledonia's economical, social and environmental developpement.

Who has a seat into CESE?

CESE ensure the representation of social professionnals: labor and trade unions, employers, associations and qualified people who contribute to the economic, social, environmental and cultural life. 41 professionnals seat in CESE in 2016.

Which are the external representations of CESE?

CESE is represented in differents provincials organisations, particularly into : New Caledonia Institute of Skills developpement, provincial council of housing environnement, Family council, Southern province mission of insertion of the young people's board of directors and general assembly, etc..

Commissions role

Commissions are loaded by the economic, social and environmental council office for the instruction of studies according to their expertises.

- each commission associates its works with associations, outside persons directly concerned by the subject and which are going to enhance the members reflection.
- The results of the works is validate by the bureau and after the assembly.

Each commission president is annually elected by its members.

- He convenes the commission which he chairs as often as necessary to study and discuss subjects for which it was seized,
- He decides the agenda and organizes the working sessions,
- He assures and signs with the reporter, the definitive writing of statements, report and project of opinion or wish. Its voice is major in case of equality during vote within the commission. In case of lack, he can be represented by his vice-president, by CESE's president or any other member designed by the commission
